Section 2: The State Executive Committee shall consist of the following members:

(A) Voting members:

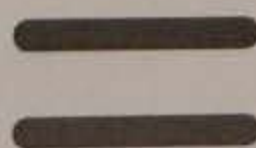
- (1) The State Chairman

- (5) The National Committeewoman
- (6) The Secretary of the State Central Committee
- (7) The Treasurer of the State Central Committee
- (8) The Region Chairmen

(B) Non-voting (ex-officio) members:

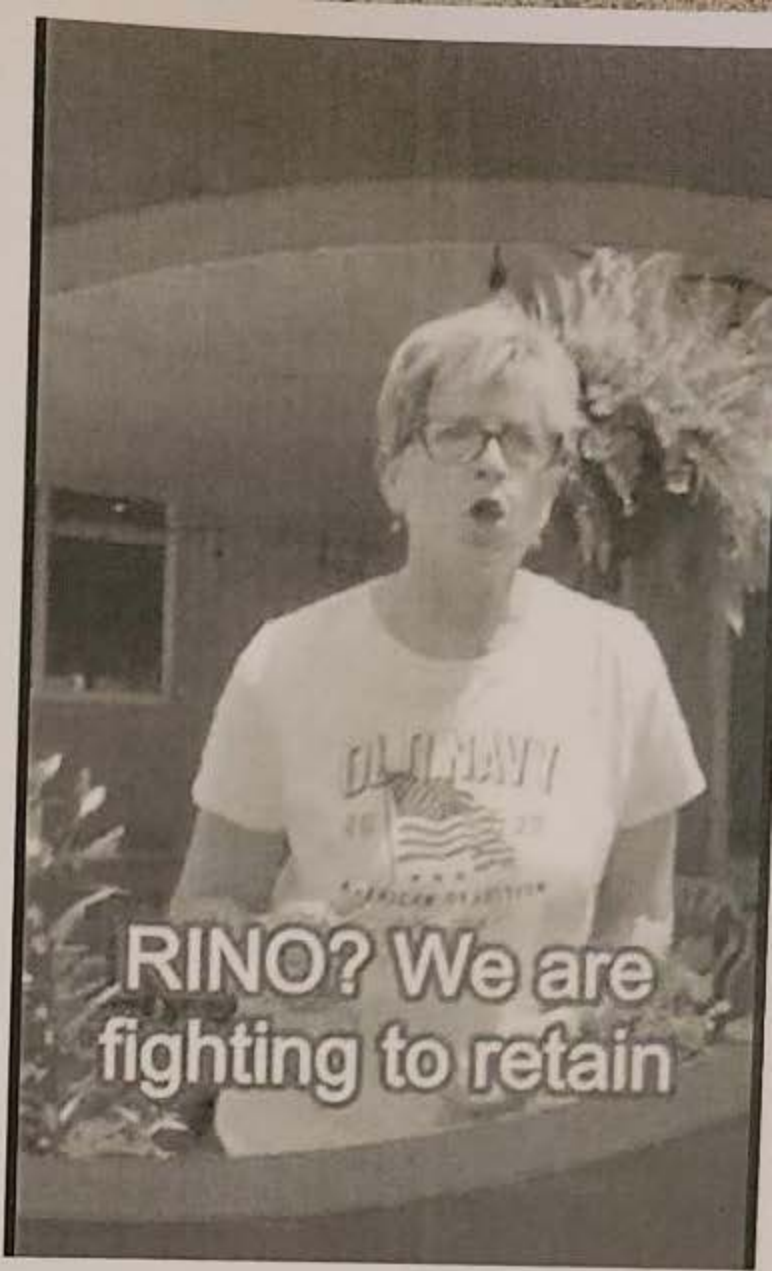

## The Party of Lincoln Needs More Young Voices, Now More Than Ever.

Thanks to the efforts of Young Republicans across America, the conservative movement is still alive among the next generation. Young Republicans are standing up against the liberal agenda on college campuses and social media. # The Numbers Don't Lie

227 Members on the Republican State Central Committee

224 Elected thru IDGOP : 3 appointed thru private clubs (17%, or 1/6th of Exec)

44 counties w/ State Committeewoman & Youthperson ->  $44 + 44 = 88 \div 227 = .39$   
women & youth guaranteed a minimum 39% representation

Currently on State Committee:

92 Women + 56 Youth

(41%)                      (25%)

Of the 92 women, 29 hold chairmen positions: - 12 LD Chairs, 15 County Chairs, 1 Region chair & Chairwoman Moon

13 Republican Women, who meet membership requirement, being denied membership in Nez Perce County by Women's State Exec Board (happening now)

20 conservative women from Canyon County Republican Women victims of plot by Chairman Wasden to remove them in late 2021, Wasden's text messages revealed

203 Young Republican members with dues paid registered for convention  
- 132 (65%) credentialed, 71 (35%) not credentialed

IDGOP State 1st Chair Daniel Silver held secret call day before convention  
- 87 delegates added to call, excluded all North Idaho & conservative delegates  
- 79 of secret call delegates voted for Silver's slate  
- 1st Chair Silver personally recruited his slate  
- 1st Chair Silver decided who received credentials AND had access to vote counting system eBallot

College Republican Chair Hibbert is the ONLY individual who determines whether anyone can join College Republicans

## Section 2: Policies

- A. The IFRW as a whole and its president shall not publicly endorse any candidate for public office in contested Republican primaries, runoff elections, special elections, or non-partisan elections when more than one Republican is in the race. Individual members of the IFRW are encouraged to work for the candidate of their choice in contested Republican primaries, but not in the name of the IFRW.
- B. Neither the IFRW nor an individual member shall advocate a split ticket, support a candidate on an opposition ticket, or act against the NFRW or IFRW policies and bylaws.

### ARTICLE III – MEMBERSHIP

#### Section 1. Good Standing of Members and Clubs

An individual member in good standing is one whose dues are paid to her local club prior to June 1st and who supports Article II of these bylaws. A local club in good standing has paid current dues and service charges to the IFRW prior to June 1st of each calendar year. Membership expires each year on December 31. Renewing members remain in good standing through the last day of February of the following year. If member dues are not received by March 1, a member is dropped from membership and loses all member privileges until dues are paid.

#### Section 2. Eligibility for Members

Membership shall be extended to all duly affiliated Republican Women who support Article II, Purposes and Policies, of these bylaws.

### ARTICLE V – OFFICERS AND THEIR DUTIES

#### Section 1. Elected Officers

The elected officers of this organization shall be: president, first vice president, second vice president, secretary, treasurer, and a director for each congressional district.

#### Section 2. Eligibility

- A. Each elected officer, appointed officer, chairmen and member of standing and special committees shall be a member in good standing in a local federated club.
- B. The president, first vice president, and second vice president shall have previously served a minimum of one year on the IFRW Board of Directors as an elected IFRW officer, as president of a local club, or as chair of a standing committee.
- C. The first and second vice president shall be from different congressional districts.

IGOP 1st Vice Chair Daniel Silver

Personally recruited all candidates who "won" the Jan 2023 Convention  
 Led credentialing for convention and personally denied delegates who paid their dues on time the right to vote. Their \$money\$ was not returned.

Had admin access to eBallot system used for vote counting

Held Secret Call with 87 of 203 convention delegates day before convention

His candidates "won" their races 79 - 53 votes

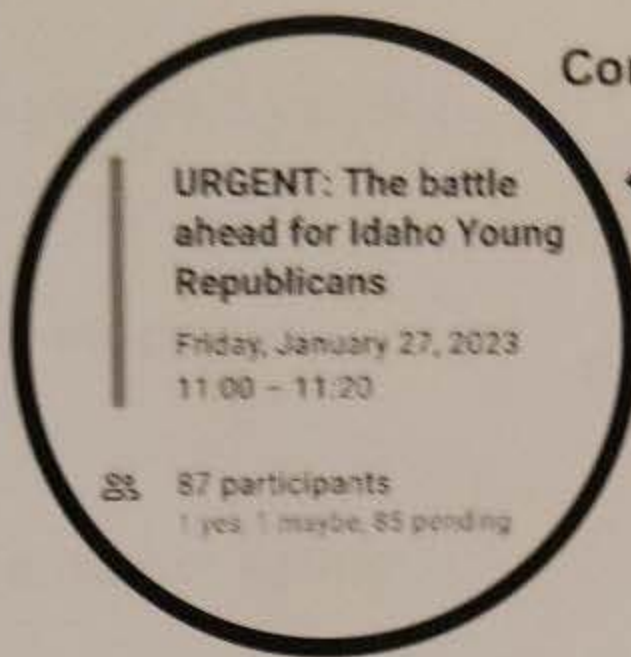
71 delegates (35%) did NOT receive credentials on the day of the election, yet at least 79 of his selected 87 delegates (91%) were credentialed & presumably voted for his slate

Only 53 of 124 delegates NOT on the secret call were credentialed (42%)

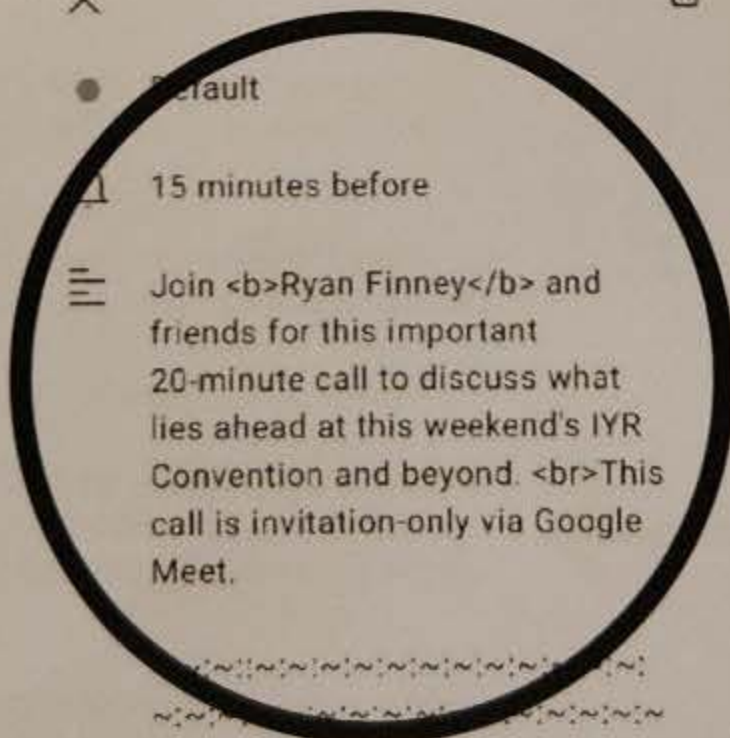

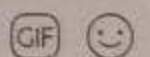
